Next Sunday, Mary will be taking on the role of guest editor for the Countryfile episode, and will see her track her life connected to farming, including her early memories as a young farmer, and her career as a whole.

This will include going on the hunt for edible fungi, rounding up a bull and his herd, and trying out cheesemaking.
